We, at FEIF Youth work, have expanded our remit to include the age group 18-26 when great changes take place in the lives of young people. Future leaders are emerging, and we want to encourage and support that development.

To that purpose, we are offering a series of annual seminars where we develop and practice skills on leadership in relation to others, and also in relation to our horses. How do I build a team? What is the difference between teamwork and partnership? How do I practice communication at a higher level?

The event is part-theoretical and part-practical but you do not need to bring your own horse. Places are limited, and the maximum number of participants is 30.

Age group: 18 – 26 years. (Eligible are young people who will TURN 18 to 27 years of age in the year of the seminar).

Number of participants: **max 3 participants per country** (number of participants limited to 30 persons).
